Thank you for volunteering to foster a pet for the Junior Humane Society. We do not have a facility, so we depend on foster homes for help. Your help makes a difference in the life of the pet you foster.

As a foster person, you are assuming care of this pet including food, water, shelter, and lots of love and patience. In some cases, you may be the first person to ever give them these gifts that will allow them to become a well-adjusted member of a family.

JHS will pay for any required vet visits. You, as the foster parent, would need to transport the animal for these appointments. You will need a JHS voucher to present to the vets office at the time of the appointment. Should a medical emergency occur, call Frankie Van Horn Harris at (850) 968-3260 as soon as possible. Foster parents transport the pet to and from adoption events and screen people interested in adopting. As a foster, you are part of the process of determining who would be a good adopter for your foster pet.

If you are able to donate monthly flea and heartworm protection for your foster pet it would be greatly appreciated. If not, please inform Frankie that you will need her to supply these items.

Foster pets are to remain in your care and not left with others unless it has been approved by JHS. Should you be unable to continue foster care, you will need to contact Frankie to make other arrangements.
